

CAMP Beyond the Scars

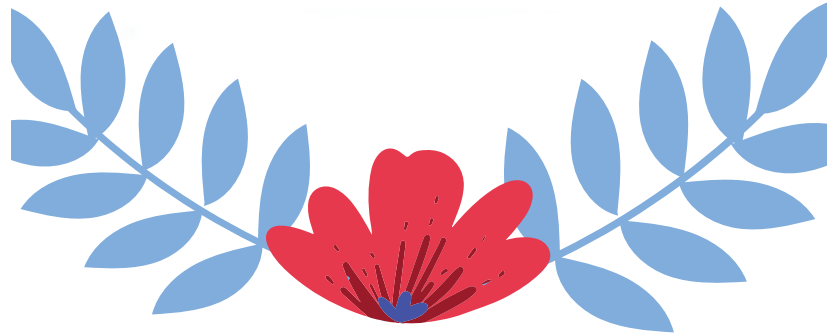
Since its inception in 1987, Camp Beyond the Scars has helped thousands of burn-injured children. The activities at camp build self-esteem, develop coping skills, help campers overcome traumatizing burn experiences, and provide the kids with a community of support. The confidence, acceptance and friendships nurtured at camp will last a lifetime and have proven to be an effective means of boosting the rehabilitation of these young survivors.

In 2020 Camp Beyond the Scars went virtual to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the campers. Kids and their families crafted, cooked, sang, and read throughout the day, then at night they met with their "cabins" via Zoom to share and learn. Camp allows these young survivors to understand that they are not alone in their healing journey and helps transform them from burn victims into burn survivors.

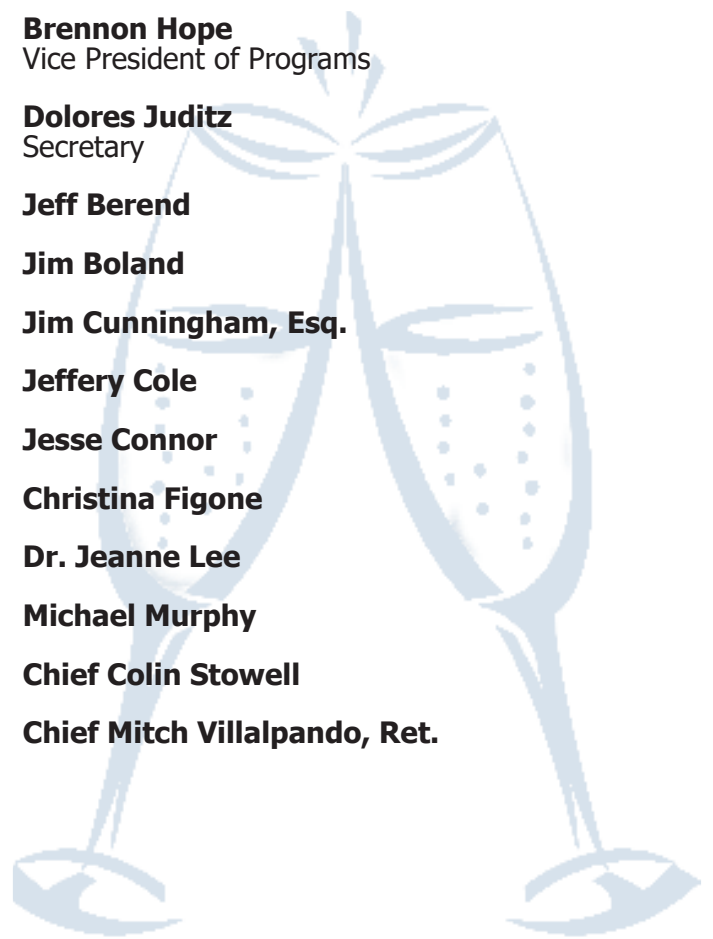
